Subject: Procurement Integrity Certification

Category: Lease Acquisition

For all competitive acquisitions of lease space or fee title, all Government parties involved in the acquisition, other than the warranted Real Property Contracting Officer must sign a Procurement Integrity Certificate. The original signed certificate for each individual is to be retained by the Real Property Contracting Officer and kept with the lease file.



PROCUREMENT INTEGRITY CERTIFICATION

I, _____, hereby certify, pursuant to subsection 27(e)(4) of the Office of Federal Procurement Policy Act (41 U.S.C. 423(e)(4)), that I understand the obligation not to disclose proprietary or source selection information to anyone not authorized by the warranted real property contracting officer to have access to such information.
