"ATTENTION ALL HANDS: PERSONNEL ARE WORKING ALOFT AT THIS TIME. DO NOT ENERGIZE ANY HIGH-POWERED RADIO TRANSMITTERS OR RADAR SYSTEMS; DO NOT LIGHT OFF ENGINES, BLOW TUBES OR LIFT SAFETY VALVES; AND DO NOT OPERATE THE SHIP'S WHISTLE UNTIL WORK ALOFT IS COMPLETE."

Upon completion of work aloft operations, the following announcement shall be made over the ship's public address system:

"ATTENTION ALL HANDS: WORK ALOFT IS NOW COMPLETE. NORMAL AND ROUTINE WORK MAY BE CARRIED OUT IN ACCORDANCE WITH PREVIOUS INSTRUCTIONS."

Signatures are required before work aloft commences to indicate concurrence with preparatory arrangements. Initials are required after work aloft is completed to indicate notification that Lock Out /			END TIME
