the CWIP CA500D Report

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Importance of Accuracy

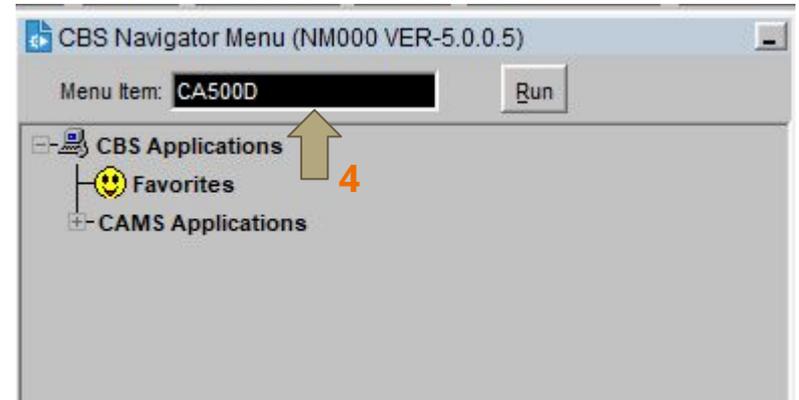
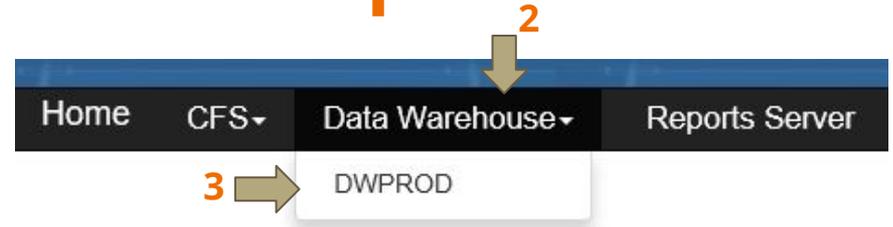
The CBS CWIP Report (CA500D) functions as NOAA's official subsidiary ledger for CWIP costs. When the report goes uncorrected, it creates a control weakness over the completeness and reliability of the CWIP costs that are reported on NOAA's financial statements.

Processing the report: Quick Steps

1. Log into CBS.
2. Click on Data Warehouse.
3. Click on DWPROD.
4. Type “CA500D” in the Menu Item box.
5. Click Run or Enter.
6. Adjust the “As of GL End Date” if necessary.
7. Change the “Project Type” field to limit the results to All, CWIP & CWIPC, or IUSD & IUSDC.
8. Change the “Task Code” to Yes to include project task codes.
9. Change the “Purge Report” to Yes if necessary.
10. Click Run Report.
11. The report can be accessed in the Report Server on the CBS Financial Portal Home Page.

Processing the Report: Detailed Steps

1. Log into CBS.
2. Click on Data Warehouse.
3. Click on DWPROD.
4. Type "CA500D" in the Menu Item box.
5. Click Run or press Enter on keyboard.



Processing the Report: Detailed Steps Continued...

6. Adjust the “As of GL End Date” if necessary.
7. Change the “Project Type” field to limit the results to All, CWIP & CWIPC, or IUSD & IUSDC.
8. Change the “Task Code” to Yes to include project codes and project task codes.
9. Change the “Purge Report” to Yes if necessary.
10. Click “Run Report”.

Report Results: Accessing the Report

11. Click back to the CBS Financial Portal home page.

- A. Click Reports Server.
- B. Depending on the size of the report, the report may take a few minutes and be Queued.
- C. Click the Refresh button frequently until the Status Code changes to "Past."
- D. Click the blue linked report under the "Name" column.

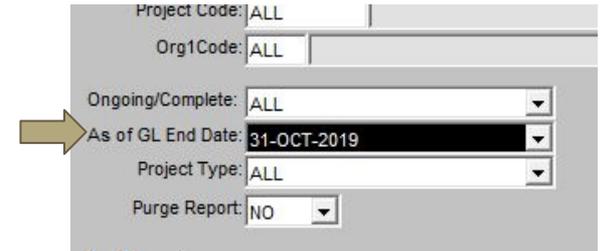
Reporting Options: GL End Date

The “As of GL End Date” is the end of the accounting period in which the report will run.

Example #1: If today were October 15, 2019 and you wanted reporting data through September, the GL End Date would be 30-Sep-2019.

Example #2: If today were October 15, 2019 and you wanted the most current data, the GL End Date would be 31-Oct-2019.

Note: Because CBS updates nightly, reporting is only current through the prior day. In Example #2, the data on the report would be current through October 14th.

Reporting Options: Project Type

“Project Types” are established for project codes using the CBS screen CM004.

The CWIP CA500D provides 3 ways to run the report by “Project Type”:

1. All - Includes both CWIP(C) & IUSD(C) project codes.
2. CWIP & CWIPC - Construction of Equipment & Buildings.
3. IUSD & IUSDC - Development of Internal Use Software.

Selecting one of these options can be used as a report parameter and eliminate unnecessary information.

Reporting Options: Project Code

CBS allows the option to run the CWIP CA500D report by a single Project Code number.

1. Click on the down arrow in the "Project Code" box.
2. Type the Project Code in the Find box next to the "%" symbol.
3. Click the "Find" button.
4. The matching result will be highlighted in blue.
5. Click the "OK" button. This will confirm the report pulls data on that single project code.



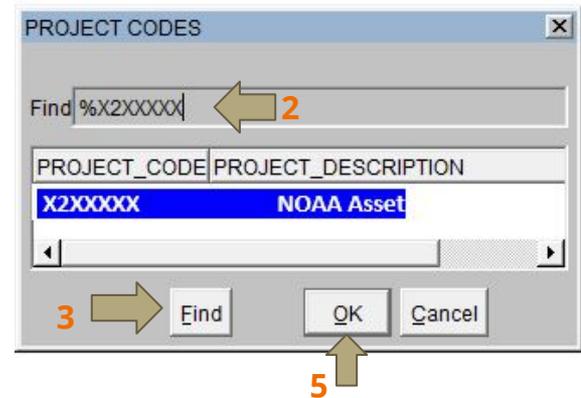

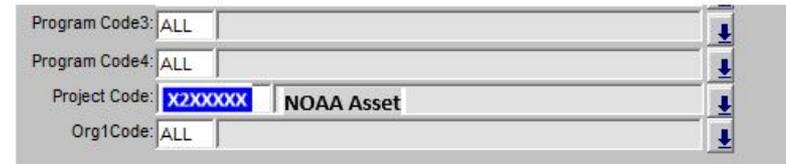

Reporting Options: Purge Criteria

The CBS CWIP Report (CA500D) “PURGE” capability will remove completed CWIP project codes (not delete them) from the report. For project codes to be “purged” from the report, they must meet the following criteria:

1. The CBS project code “Project Type” is marked as CWIPC or IUSDC, **AND**
2. Undelivered Orders net to \$0, **AND**
3. Uncapitalized Costs net to \$0, **AND**
4. Unpaid Costs net to \$0

When a CWIP activity is complete, and the criteria above has been met, the CWIP Activity Manager must notify the FO-FSB and request the CWIP project code “Project Type” be changed from “CWIP” to “CWIPC” or “IUSD” to “IUSDC” for all project codes associated with the completed CWIP activity. This will allow the projects to purge from the CBS CWIP report.

Understanding the Report: Basic Information

The CWIP (CA500D) report is a cost report located in the Data Warehouse (DW) of CBS and is based on the NOAA DW Standard General Ledger Account Summary table. The (CA500D) report provides cumulative information on undelivered orders, unpaid costs, paid costs, total costs, total obligations, capitalized costs, and uncapitalized costs for all CWIP and Internal Use Software in Development (IUSD) project and task codes.

The information on the report is displayed by Fund Code, Project/Task Code, Fund Code Fiscal Year, Organization Code, and Object Class Code. The report is driven by "Project Type" (CWIP/IUSD). "Project Types" are established for project codes upon their set up. "Project Type" information includes the following:

Project Type	Description	SGL Account Number
CWIP & CWIPC	Construction of Equipment and Buildings	172000
IUSD & IUSDC	Development of Internal Use Software	183200

Note: Two reasons a project code might NOT appear on this report are:

1. The project code was set up with a "Project Type" other than CWIP or IUSD.
2. The project code has not incurred any costs.

Understanding the Report: Impact of a NF 37-6

When an asset is placed in service, the CWIP Activity Manager must complete the Report of Property Constructed (NF 37-6) to transfer costs from CWIP to PP&E (i.e. capitalizes the asset).

The FO-FSB uses the NF 37-6 to prepare a general journal (GJ) entry in CBS to capitalize assets relating to CWIP. The entry of the NF 37-6 into CBS reduces the Uncapitalized Costs (Column G) for each project and task code on the CA500D by the amounts noted on the 37-6. As a result, the Capitalized Costs (Column F) for each project and task code will increase by the same amounts.

EXAMPLE: Impact of the 37-6 on the CA500D

EXAMPLE: FO-FSB receives the NF 37-6 shown below capitalizing an additional \$200,000 and prepares a GJ to upload into CBS.

Impact of a Cancelling Fund Code

Any CWIP balances in cancelling fund codes will be transferred to the respective 'X' or no-year appropriation. Note: Both the cancelling fund project/task code and the new project/task code should be considered when reviewing the costs reported on the CA500D report.

Effect on CA500D after the CWIP balance is moved from the cancelling fund code to the no year fund code:

CA500D Column	Cancelled Project/Task Code	New project/task code
Total Costs (D)	Same as before, showing the correct amount.	\$0 (only CWIP costs are transferred, not original costs)
Uncapitalized Cost (CWIP) (G)	\$0	Amount previously in Cancelled Project/Task Code.
Capitalized Cost (F)	Same as Total Costs due to formula (Total Costs minus Uncapitalized Cost)	Negative amount of Uncapitalized (CWIP) costs due to formula (Total Costs minus Uncapitalized Cost).

Effect of Transfer-In of Assets to NOAA

When an asset is transferred into NOAA from another Federal agency, and the asset is part of a CWIP activity, the asset is recorded on NOAA's books as a transfer-in of CWIP (into SGL Account 172000). As a result, it will reflect similarly to that of cancelling fund codes on the CBS CWIP Report (CA500D) until the asset is capitalized by the NF 37-6.
